At Poppy's, we believe funerals have the potential to be life and grief-changing experiences. With an open and honest approach, we encourage, reassure, guide and support families to have the funeral that they want - whatever that means to them.

We're looking for organised, responsible, strong people to help assist with the smooth-running of our practical work, in and around our mortuary, on a part time basis. Duties include, but are not limited to the following:

- Being responsible for the smooth running of the practical elements of the funeral
- Working under the direction of the Logistics and Mortuary Team to look after people in our mortuary and get them ready for their funerals or for visits from family and friends in line with our natural, gentle approach. This can include washing and dressing, placing in their coffin, and observing any other requests the family may have.
- Communicating proposed plans clearly to the funeral director and being responsible for ensuring they have everything they need, specific to each individual funeral
- Managing and preparing the bearers at funerals including communicating clearly to the practical support and/or family
- Carrying the coffin at funerals
- Collecting people who have died from their home, hospital or care home, with relevant paperwork and being fastidious in ensuring all is in order
- Support on call for out of hours calls (1wk in 7)
- Lining coffins, cleaning vehicles and other practical tasks
- Vehicle and building maintenance

All training will be given on site and new staff will initially be paired with a more experienced staff member.
